


- Worth \$60-\$90 million







²⁹ And everyone who has left houses or brothers or sisters or father or mother or wife or children or fields for my sake will receive a hundred times as much and will inherit eternal life.


Eternal Life of Intimate Relationship with God


A Life of the New Covenant
