
Bible Ref: Matthew 8:1-17 NIV

Jesus reached out his hand and touched the man. "I am willing," he said. "Be clean!" Immediately he was cleansed of his leprosy. Then Jesus said to him, "See that you don't tell anyone. 
The crowd were amazed at his teaching, because he taught as one who had authority.


The Jewish Leprosy Sufferer

Faith and Healing

Grave consequence
