






"He is Beelzebul"


Agent of Satan!



A Divided Kingdom cannot stand

²⁵ Jesus knew their thoughts and said to them, 'Every kingdom divided against itself will be ruined...
²⁶ If Satan drives out Satan, he is divided against himself. How then can his kingdom stand?

Jesus is a stronger man




Kingdom of God has come

³⁰ 'Whoever is not with me is against me, and whoever does not gather with me scatters.




Jesus the Judge

³¹ And so I tell you, every kind of sin and slander can be forgiven, but blasphemy against the Spirit will not be forgiven.

The Unpardonable Sin

A deliberate, conscious, and defiant act of denial of God's Spirit power is unforgivable



Speaking Against the Holy Spirit is Unforgivable

32 Anyone who speaks a word against the Son of Man will be forgiven, but anyone who speaks against the Holy Spirit will not be forgiven, either in this age or in the age to come.

Hardened Stubborn Hearts of Unbelief

A refusal to ask for forgiveness



Anyone who reject Jesus or the work of the Spirit will not be forgiven/saved

- John 16:8


 It is the Spirit who convicts us of our sin, our unbelief
- John 15:26 The Spirit bears witness to Christ A rejection of the Spirit is a rejection of Christ




Jesus Judge a man by his fruit

Good tree & good fruit Bad tree & bad fruit






Judgment of Fruit by Your Words


³⁴ You brood of vipers, how can you who are evil say anything good? For the mouth speaks what the heart is full of.

Listen to what you say

your heart






The heart is a treasury of good or evil

³⁵ A good man brings good things out of the good stored up in him, and an evil man brings evil things out of the evil stored up in him.

If the tree/heart is good, good fruit/word will come out and vice versa.



Beware! Everyone will be judged by his word

³⁶ But I tell you that everyone will have to give account on the day of judgment for every empty word they have spoken.
³⁷ For by your words you will be acquitted, and by your words you will be condemned.'

Our Words Reveal Our Hearts and Characters
