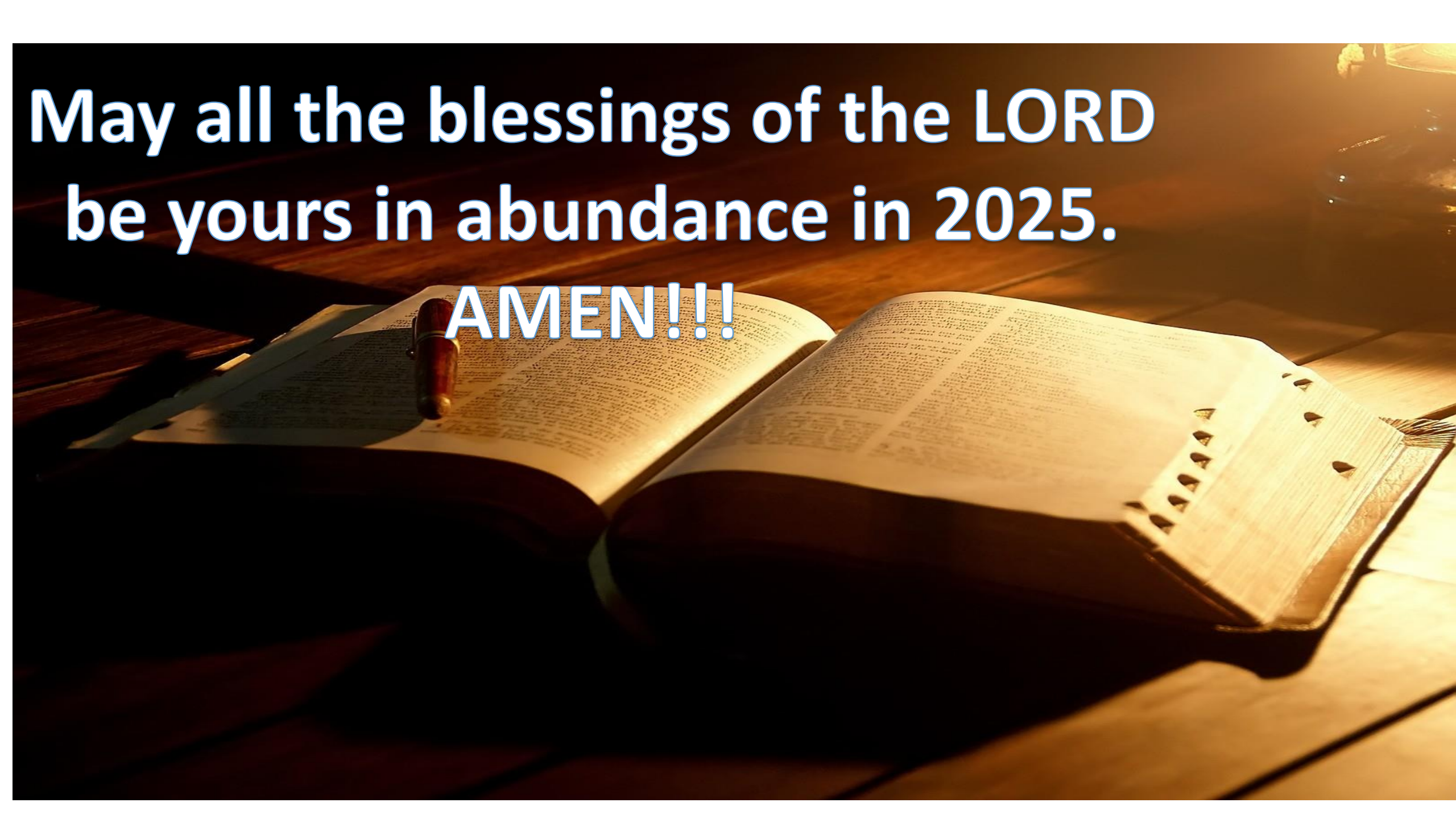



The Valley of Baca

Psalms 84:6

Psalms 84:1-12

- A Pilgrim's Psalm.
- All able-bodied Jewish men are required to perform their pilgrimage to Jerusalem 3X a year; to celebrate the Passover, Shavout & Sukkhot
- Some have to travel great distances, through difficult terrain, with much difficulties and hardship to get to the Temple in Jerusalem.

Valley of Baca

- Mentioned only once in the Bible.
- Location unknown, probably not an actual geographical location but figurative.
- “Baca” means weeping, tears. American Bible teacher Warren Wiersbe defines Baca as - “Any difficult or painful place in life, where everything seems hopeless, feel helpless, in the pit of despair.”

“The Valley of Baca” represents

- Difficult times, rough patch in life
- Challenges, feelings of failure and defeat
- Despair, darkness, bleak future
- Discouragement
- Low points in life, setbacks
- Challenges – physical, emotional

Sooner or later, every child of God
(even though blessed with every
spiritual blessings in the heavenlies)
will find himself/herself passing
through the valley of Baca (filling it
with tears).

But God's promises are crystal clear;
we can be more than conquerors
through Christ who loved us, in spite
of these hard and difficult
circumstances of life.

- Psalm 84:7. “They go from strength to strength.” Not our own but the Lord’s strength. “Blessed are those whose strength is in You” (v.5). Blessed is the man who trusts in the LORD (v.12). We cannot rely on flesh; God’s strength and grace are completely sufficient.
See Jeremiah 17
- Weeping may remain for a night, but rejoicing comes in the morning” (Psalm 30:5). “*passing through* the valley of Baca v6; *walk through* the valley of the shadow Ps23:4
- God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore will not we fear” (Psalm 46:1,2).

1Kings 20:23-28

- Meanwhile, the officials of the king of Aram advised him, “Their gods are gods of the hills. That is why they were too strong for us. But if we fight them on the plains, surely we will be stronger than they. Do this: Remove all the kings from their commands and replace them with other officers. You must also raise an army like the one you lost—horse for horse and chariot for chariot—so we can fight Israel on the plains. Then surely we will be stronger than they.” He agreed with them and acted accordingly.

1Kings 20:23-28

- The next spring Ben-Hadad mustered the Arameans and went up to Aphek to fight against Israel. When the Israelites were also mustered and given provisions, they marched out to meet them. The Israelites camped opposite them like two small flocks of goats, while the Arameans covered the countryside.
The man of God came up and told the king of Israel, “This is what the LORD says: ‘Because the Arameans think the LORD is a god of the hills and not a god of the valleys, I will deliver this vast army into your hands, and **you will know that I am the LORD.**’”
