

### **Miracles and Controversy**

At that time Herod the tetrarch heard the reports about Jesus, <sup>2</sup> and he said to his attendants, 'This is John the Baptist; he has risen from the dead! That is why miraculous powers are at work in him.'

Herod was Confused about Jesus

Jesus was John Resurrected!




### **Herod arrested John**

<sup>3</sup> Now Herod had arrested John and bound him and put him in prison because of Herodias, his brother Philip's wife, <sup>4</sup> for John had been saying to him: 'It is not lawful for you to have her.' <sup>5</sup> Herod wanted to kill John, but he was afraid of the people, because they considered John a prophet.

Seduced and eloped with Herodias who was the wife of his half-brother Herod Philip I.


### King Herod the Tetrarch

#### Son of Herod the Great

A 'tetrarch', ruled over the 4<sup>th</sup> part of the kingdom of Galilee and Perea.

### Herodias & Herod Philip I

Herodias was a daughter of Aristobulus, a niece to Herod and Herod Philip I. Herod Agrippa I, was her brother





### **Herodias plotted John's death**

<sup>6</sup> On Herod's birthday the daughter of Herodias danced for the guests and pleased Herod so much <sup>7</sup> that he promised with an oath to give her whatever she asked.<sup>8</sup> Prompted by her mother, she said, 'Give me here on a dish the head of John the Baptist.'

Salome, the daughter of Herodias Danced for John's head

### John was Beheaded

The king was distressed, but because of his oaths and his dinner guests, he ordered that her request be granted
 and had John beheaded in the prison.
 His head was brought in on a dish and given to the girl, who carried it to her mother.

Martyred!

"For even his own brother did not believe in him."




### Nicodemus! John 3: 2

More Christians martyred in the twentieth century than in the first nineteen centuries after the birth of Christ.






## Being a kingdom disciple will cost us something!

John's death was honoured but life and work of the kingdom continued




### **Testimony of Manaen**

A foster brother and friend brought up in the palace court who chose to follow Jesus



### Joanna, wife of Cuza, manager of Herod's household

**Luke 8:3** Joanna the wife of Chuza, the manager of Herod's household; Susanna; and many others. These women were helping to support them out of their own means.

Cured of her disease and became a follower & supporter of Jesus' ministry

#### Luke 24:10

One of the women who witnessed the first resurrection of Jesus.


